Loose-fitting pants, jeans, or knee-length fashions may be worn. Please bring a knee-length skirt or dress for the Thursday evening service.

Men/boys' note: Any fashion worn must come at least to the top of the knee. Sagging pants and inappropriate holes are not acceptable camp attire. Please bring long pants and a collared shirt for the Thursday evening service.

Meals: A sack lunch will be needed for Monday. All other

meals are included through breakfast on Friday.
